

FAQ's

Q. What is stored in the base station?

A. Anything set in the “advanced/super user” menu will remain in memory until being changed by the user or until all settings are reset all/done!

Even if power is shut down, the settings will remain in memory. Note: Removal or replacement of the batteries will reset all settings to their default values.

Q. What is the range of the Pro Com 4?

A. Six hundred feet line of site.

Q. What reduces the range of the Pro Com 4?

A. Obstructions. Especially metal trailers, motor homes, metallic buildings, and earth barriers.

Q. Can you increase the range with aluminum or tin foil?

A. No. The Pro Com 4 operates in the 913 MH range and the antenna must be of an exact wavelength for maximum range.

Q. How do you replace the base station 9volt battery? (Lithium recommended)

Q. Will interference from another Pro Com 4 jam my control?

A. No, unlike inexpensive temp monitors, the Pro Com 4 operates on a publisher/subscriber system that has a unique, identifying serial number code so that an unlimited number of controls can be operated in any given area.
